

The learner will be required to complete two tasks.

At the B1 level the learner will be asked to write between 75 – 100 words for Task 1, between 100 – 125 words for Task 2.

The learner will be assessed on content; use of conjunctions; adjectives and vocabulary; use of appropriate tenses; word order. Time allowed is 1 hour.

Accuracy of Grammar	<p>Recognising punctuation and grammar correctly Used basic grammar and present tense forms accurately, punctuation accurate throughout, accurate word order, use of compound and complex sentences, attempts a range of verb forms (e.g. present perfect, past continuous, future simple).</p> <p>Minor errors in basic grammar and present tense forms, some punctuation errors, mostly accurate word order, some evidence of compound and complex sentences, some errors in attempts at a range of verb forms (e.g. present perfect, past continuous, future simple). 	<p>Errors in basic grammar and present tense forms, punctuation and word order, lacks use of more complex sentence structures. Many errors in attempts at a range of verbs forms (e.g. present perfect, past continuous, future simple). Some comprehension is impeded.</p> <p>Does not produce a comprehensible text. Many errors in punctuation. Little or no understanding of grammatical forms, tenses inaccurate throughout.</p>	<p>1</p> <p>0</p>	
Range of vocab	<p>Good range of appropriate vocabulary relevant to level. Effective use of nouns. Conjunctions used effectively. Four or more adjectives used.</p> <p>Some appropriate use of vocabulary. Nouns used well. Conjunctions used correctly. Two or three adjectives used.</p> <p>Limited use of appropriate vocabulary. Lacks range of nouns. At least one adjective used correctly. Attempts at conjunctions, not always correctly.</p> <p>Incorrect use of vocabulary throughout. Does not produce a legible text.
